To achieve:

- Efficient communication pathway between ELFT and Social Care
- Appropriately skilled ELFT and Social Care staff
- Appropriate information sharing across services and with customers

2. "I want autism to be included in local strategic needs assessments so that person centred local health, care and support services, based on good information about local needs, is available for people with autism"

To achieve:

- Ensure JSNA is up to date with appropriate local autism information
- Social care assessments empower customers to understand their rights
- The local autism partnership board members to use the JSNA information as appropriate

3. "I want staff in health and social care services to understand that I have autism and how this affects me"

To achieve:

- Staff trained appropriately across health and social care
- Staff to make autism friendly reasonable adjustments
- Customers feeling happy and understood when travelling through health and social care processes

4. "I want to know that my family can get help and support when they need it"

To achieve:

- Carers recognised
- Carers assessments available
- Appropriate support available for carers and families as required
