




### What age group are you in or do you mainly work with?

- Families should be invited to attend meetings for Local Authority Housing. The consultations at coal face are vital.
- There is a lack of specialist supported accommodation for higher functioning adults. We do get frequent enquiries from clinical colleagues in Mental Health particularly trying to source accommodation services for people who need support, particularly who have co-morbid mental health support needs.
- Particularly in Luton, there seems to be very few options available for people who would find it stressful to live in a flat (due to noise sensitivity) and would like to live with their family in a house. (but don't have challenging behaviour or mental health needs that meet criteria for (MHT input) or learning disability.
- The option of supported living for adults on the spectrum with some on site support.
- Cannot stress enough the need for the professionals to be trained in Autism - fully understand and accept the individual's needs and not to forget the carers - who have been just that for a lifetime!
- This meeting was useful and informative. Autism training will be useful.
