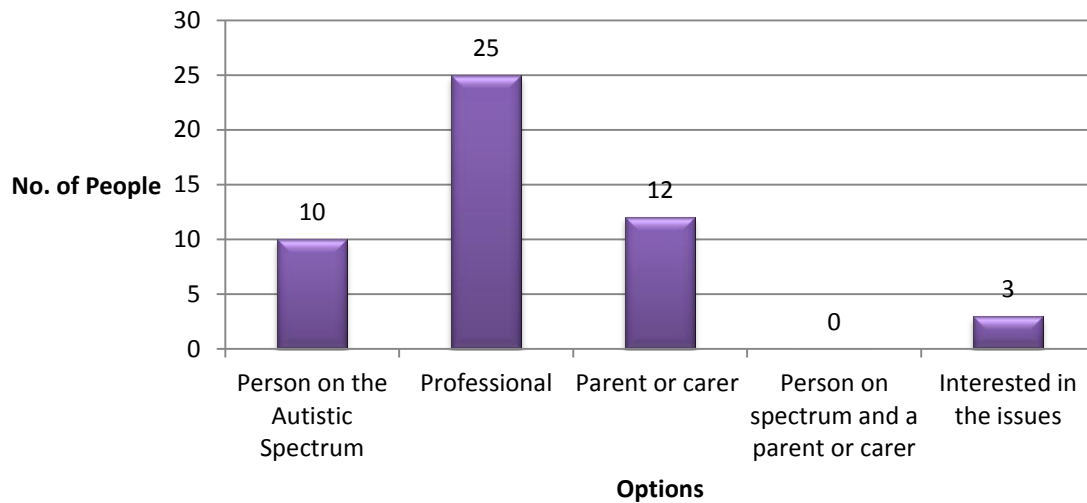
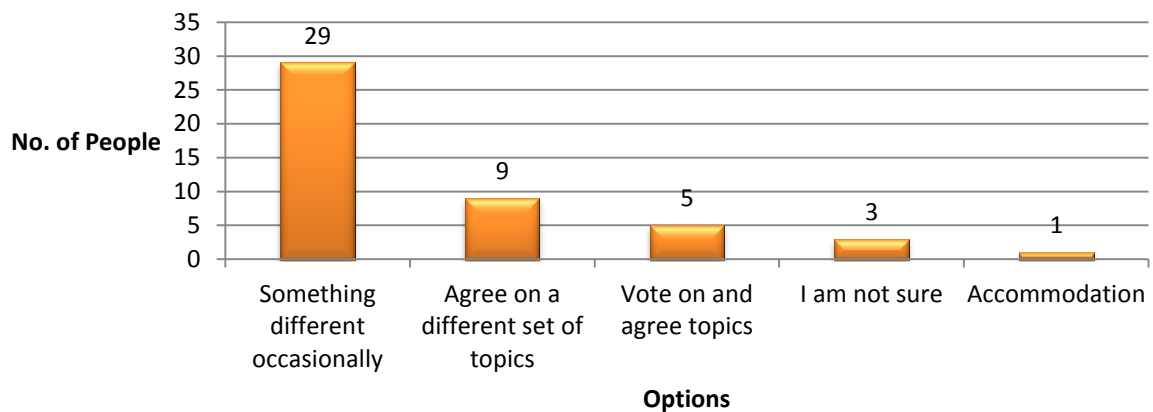


In what capacity were you here today?
